

HEALTH & SAFETY

How to Prevent Falls

Falls can be a serious health risk, especially for older adults. However, many falls are preventable. Follow these tips to stay safe, keep your body strong, and maintain your independence.

Exercise

Participate in activities such as walking, Tai Chi, yoga, or dancing to help you stay strong and flexible and improve your balance. Make sure to keep up with your exercise program if your doctor or therapist has given you one.

Review Your Medicines

Talk with your healthcare provider about all the medicines you take, including prescriptions, over-the-counter medicines, and supplements. Some combinations of medicines can make you tired or dizzy. These side effects can increase your chance of falling.

Have Your Vision Checked

Have your vision checked by an eye doctor every year. Wearing the correct prescription lenses will make sure you can see clearly. If your vision is poor, your chances of falling are higher.

Wear Supportive Shoes

Choose shoes that fit snugly with non-slip soles and a flat or low, wide heel. Avoid slippers, flip flops, backless shoes, high heels, and shoes with smooth leather soles.

Make Your Living Environment Safe

- Remove tripping hazards, such as loose rugs and clutter
- Add handrails to stairs and bathrooms
- Use non-slip mats in the bathtub and shower
- Add lighting in dark areas

How to Get Up After a Fall

Step 1: Roll to your side and push your upper body off the floor.

Step 2: Crawl to a chair or sturdy piece of furniture.

Step 3: Place your hands on the chair and one foot flat on the floor.

Step 4: Push up from the floor.



Step 5: Turn your body to sit in the chair and rest for a few minutes.



If you have an injury or health condition that makes you more likely to fall at home, it is important to learn how to get up safely. Getting up from a fall correctly can help you avoid making an injury worse.

To get up after a fall:

- First, look for a chair, staircase, or other sturdy piece of furniture that is close to you.
- Roll onto your side by turning your head in the direction you want to roll, then moving your shoulder and arm, followed by your hip and leg.
- Next, slowly push your upper body up. After lifting your head, take a moment to rest. Slowly move to your hands and knees, then crawl to the chair or other sturdy furniture.
- Put your hands on the chair and place one foot forward so it's flat on the floor. Your other leg should be bent with your knee on the floor.
- Slowly push up from the floor. As you rise, turn your body to sit in the chair.
- Sit for a few minutes before trying to do anything else. Even if you feel okay, tell someone what happened. You might not know that you have an injury.
